### Anne-Corinne Beaver, MD

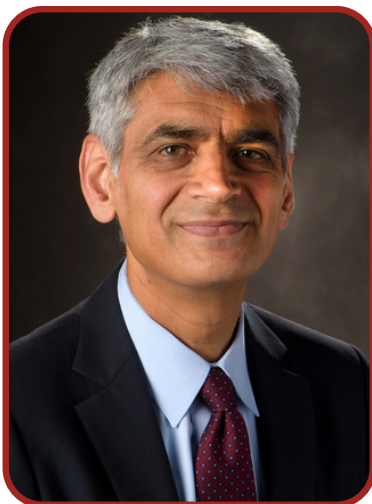

### Muzaffar H. Qazilbash, MD



Muzaffar H. Qazilbash, MD, is a Professor in the Department of Stem Cell Transplantation and Cellular Therapy, Division of Cancer Medicine, at The University of Texas MD Anderson Cancer Center in Houston, Texas. He serves as Director of Myeloma Transplantation and Cellular Therapy, a role he has held since 2017, where he leads specialized efforts in the treatment of myeloma through advanced transplantation and cellular therapy approaches.

Additionally, Dr. Qazilbash has served as Co-Director of the Stem Cell Transplantation Fellowship Program since 2008, demonstrating a longstanding commitment to training the next generation of transplantation specialists. He has received several institutional and national awards for his dedication to clinical medicine, including the University Cancer Foundation Award for Excellence in Patient Care in 2021 at the MD Anderson Cancer Center.
